Andrew is known as the Hat man, but also demonstrates other skills

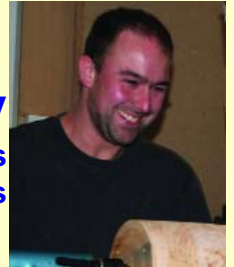


From England, Carlyn Lindsay

From Newtownards, Mark Hanvey

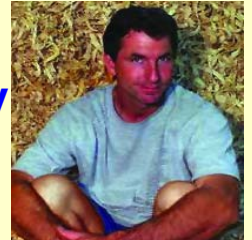
Mark is one of the most respected of our local woodturners who is renowned for his innovative work and his skill with veneers
